1 Purpose

It is the policy of the University of Venda to forfeit part of the minimum payment paid by students to the University.

2. DEFINITION

"Forfeit" Amount deducted from the minimum deposit if the applicant does not turn up for registration.

3. RULES

The rules that apply to forfeiting part of the minimum payment are as follows:

3.1 Minimum Payments

3.1.1 Refer to the general rules and regulations Part 1, chapter 2.

4. PROCEDURE

The following rules apply for the different reasons for cancellation:

- 4.1 The student informs the registration department in writing that he / she is not continuing his studies through our institution. The student has to provide proof of enrolment at another institution;
- 4.2 The student is referred to the Student Accounts Department to complete an Application of Refund Form;
- 4.3 The Academic Registration Department informs the student that he/she does not qualify for further studies at UNIVEN due to Matric results; and
- 4.4 The student is referred to the Student Accounts Department to complete an application of refund form.
